Faith → complete trust or confidence in a person or thing; obligation of loyalty or fidelity to a person; allegiance to someone or something

- When we do something in good faith – generally we trust that we are going to come through
- When someone is faithful – generally we trust that they will come through

Q. What deeds do you do daily that requires faith?

- Driving without being in an accident
- Getting up each morning to face the day

Q. What *religious* deeds do you do that requires faith?

- Believe that Christ has risen
- Pray and send petitions to God
- Believe that through Christ, I can change for the better
- Tithing

Q. What is the difference between the two?

There is a big difference between doing things out of tradition/process/dogma...and doing something out of faith!

The book of **Hebrews** speaks of many forms of faith through men who believed.

Where or what ... do you put your faith in?

Matthew 9:35-38 ³⁵ Jesus traveled through all the towns and villages, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the Good News about the kingdom, and healing all kinds of diseases and sicknesses.³⁶ When he saw the crowds, he felt sorry for them because they were hurting and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd. ³⁷ Jesus said to his followers, "There are many people to harvest but only a few workers to help harvest them." ³⁸ Pray to the Lord, who owns the harvest, that he will send more workers to gather his harvest."

Matthew 6: 28-33 ²⁸ "And why do you worry about clothes? Look at how the lilies in the field grow. They don't work or make clothes for themselves. ²⁹ But I tell you that even Solomon with his riches was not dressed as beautifully as one of these flowers.³⁰ God clothes the grass in the field, which is alive today but tomorrow is thrown into the fire. So you can be even more sure that God will clothe you. Don't have so little faith!³¹ Don't worry and say, 'What will we eat?' or 'What will we drink?' or 'What will we wear?'³² The people who don't know God keep trying to get these things, and your Father in heaven knows you need them. ³³ Seek first God's kingdom and what God wants. Then all your other needs will be met as well. ³⁴ So don't worry about tomorrow, because tomorrow will have its own worries. Each day has enough trouble of its own.

Then Jesus sends out the 12...

Ultimate display of faith is putting our lives aside and not focusing on ourselves, but instead...putting our time and energy into serving God and doing God's work even when it doesn't make sense to other people ... But doing it out of faith by trusting that God will take care of us and do what He has promised us.
